The school will run from 8 AM to 5 PM. The following courses will be offered:

Beginning Autocrossing: The \$75 fee includes Lunch and Sunday's Test-N-Tune.

This course is for the person who is interested in starting autocrossing or has run a few autocrosses in the past, either recent or not. There will be 4 hours of classroom instruction to open the class. During that class experienced autocrossers will present topics important to understanding the dynamics of autocrossing, driving skills, picking and preparing a car, requirements for working at an event, and the pre-registration system **CCSCC** uses. Instructors this year will be Pete Hetman, Dennis Miller and Marty Urbanc.

After lunch, each entrant will have practice time on the **autocross** course, including time with an instructor who rides along and demonstrates the skills of autocrossing. Instructors will be assigned according to their experience with similar cars. (**30** beginning students **maximum**.)

At the end of the day there will be a debriefing in the classroom to bring closure to this class.

Advanced Autocrossing: The \$50 fee includes Lunch and Sunday's Test-N-Tune. (**15** students **max**.)

This course is for the experienced autocrosser who wants to get help improving their driving skills on the **autocross** course. It is important that all people taking this course have enough **autocross** experience that they have common skills and terminology so that they can benefit from the individual attention inherent in this class.

In the morning, the students will meet their instructors, help set up a course, tech inspect their cars, walk the course and start running the course with and without instructors riding or driving with them. Each run will be evaluated by the instructor and suggestions made. Lunch will be provided and then you will be required to work the course and tech inspect the beginners' cars.

Safety Steward: This course is **free**, but to get an SCCA license, you need it & to assist at two events.

On Sunday at 10 AM there will be a safety steward course. This course is meant for people who wish to serve as **CCSCC** safety stewards or get licensed by the SCCA to be SCCA SSS's. The Solo Safety Steward instructor will help people through the requirements SCCA have for being an SSS and will also prepare the entrant to serve as an SS at **CCSCC**'s non-SCCA events.

Registration, Timing and Scoring: This course is also **free** & will be taught from 9 to 10am Sunday.

Tom Ingles will teach a course that helps students learn to use the AXWare computer program for registering entrants; setting classes, bumps and heats; timing events; and scoring winners.

Any materials to read before the courses will be emailed to entrants. All entrants and workers will get a free lunch on Saturday and free entry to the Test-N-Tune on Sunday. Some instructors will be available on Sunday to help beginners and advanced students, and may also be running their cars.
