

CHAMPAIGN COUNTY SPORTS CAR CLUB
CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this club shall be the Champaign County Sports Car Club.

ARTICLE II – OBJECT

The purpose of this corporation shall be to provide and encourage sports car activities; such as rallies, gymkhanas, hill climbs, economy runs, and other related events promoting good sportsmanship and driving skill; and to attempt to enlighten the general public of its motives through publicity and actions.

ARTICLE III – OFFICERS AND THEIR ELECTION

- SECTION 1. The officers of this club shall be a President, a Vice President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, and up to fifteen members of an Executive Board. The number of board members elected shall be at the discretion of the executive board, but in no case will be fewer than eight nor exceed fifteen. Together these officers, board members, the immediate past president, and a registered agent of the corporation known as Champaign County Sports Car Club, shall constitute the Executive Board.
- SECTION 2. The officers and board members shall be elected at a club meeting selected by the board that allows the new officers and board members to take office at the first board meeting of the new calendar year, which will be scheduled by the board during the first week of the new calendar year. The first club meeting of the new calendar year will be held during the second week of the new calendar year.
- SECTION 3. Nominees shall be members in good standing of the organization.
- SECTION 4. The term of office shall be one year. No member shall hold more than one office at a time.

SECTION 5. The annual election shall be conducted in the following fashion: The President shall open the floor to nominations for President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer in that order. After nominations are closed for these offices, he shall conduct a secret ballot. The President shall then open the floor for nominations to the Executive Board. After nominations are closed, he shall then conduct a secret ballot wherein the Executive Board shall be completed with those nominees receiving the largest number of votes. A run-off ballot will be conducted for the contested seats in case of ties.

ARTICLE IV – AMENDMENT

This constitution may be amended at any regular or adjourned regular meeting by a two-thirds vote of those members present and eligible to vote, provided the proposed amendment was presented at the previous regular meeting. Or, it may be amended at a special meeting called for that purpose, with notice of the meeting and text of the proposed amendment given to all club members no less than two weeks previous to that special meeting, by two-thirds vote of those members present and eligible to vote. All proposed amendments shall be submitted in writing to the Secretary or, in his absence, any other club officer present at the time at which the amendments are to be presented.
